# A BILL INTITULED

Title.

An Act to grant an Endowment to the Timaru Harbour Board. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Timaru Harbour Board Short Title.

5 Endowment Act, 1881."

2. In this Act the expression the "Board" means the Timaru Interpretation. Harbour Board, incorporated under "The Timaru Harbour Board Act, 1876," (hereinafter called "the said Act"), which Act shall be deemed to be incorporated with and shall be read with the said Act.

3. Upon the coming into operation of this Act the land described Land in Schedule to in the Schedule hereto shall, without any conveyance or assurance, vest in Board.

vest in the Board for an estate in fee-simple.

4. The said Board, in addition to any powers conferred by the Borrowing powers. said Act, shall have the powers vested in Harbour Boards by sections 15 one hundred and thirty-seven and one hundred and thirty-eight of "The Harbours Act, 1878;" and shall also have power to borrow, subject to the provisions of "The Harbours Act, 1878," aforesaid, any sum not exceeding thousand pounds, to be applied in and about the construction and carrying out of works for the improvement

20 of the said Port of Timaru.

### SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that parcel of land being portion of Run No. 546, in the County of Geraldine, containing about 50,500 acres, more or less. Commencing at a point on the Orari River, the said point being at the junction of Andrews' Creek with the Orari River; thence North-west along south bank of Orari River to the northwest corner of Section 34,442; thence South-west along the east bank of the south branch of the Orari River to a fence, being the boundaries of Runs 331 and 546; thence South-east along the fence, being the boundary between Runs 240 and 255 and 546, to a point on the branch of the River Hare, the said point being the boundary between the Geraldine and Mount Peel Road Boards; thence Northeast, following that boundary line, to a point on the River Waihi, the said point being the corner of Rural Section 27,542; thence North-easterly and North-

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westerly, following the boundary line of Mr. Tripp's freehold sections to a point on Andrews' Creek, and thence north-easterly along said creek to commencing point: as the same is more particularly delineated on plan and coloured green; save and

except all freehold sections within the said boundary.

All that parcel of land situate in the County of Geraldine, containing 6,412 acres, more or less. Commencing at a point on the south branch of the River Opuha, where the same is intersected by the main road from Fairlie Creek to Clayton; thence westerly, along south bank of said river to a point in the line of the western boundary line of Section 28,850, thence following said line to the boundary of said section; thence South-easterly, following boundary lines of free-hold sections to a point on the road from Ashwick to Clayton, the said point being the south-east corner of Rural Section 32,573; thence North-easterly along said road to a point being in line with the north-west boundary of Rural Section 33,202; thence South-easterly along said section to the road from Fairlie Creek to Clayton; thence Northerly, following said road to south-east corner of Rural Section 32,380; thence North-westerly, along boundary of said section to road from Ashwick to Clayton; thence North-easterly along said road to commencing point: as the same is more particularly delineated on plan marked B annexed, and coloured green.

All that parcel of land in the County of Geraldine, containing 52,580 acres, more or less. Commencing at a point on the east bank of the River Waitangi, the same being the south-west corner of Reserve 1,358; thence South-easterly and Easterly, following said river, to a point being the south-east corner of Run 606; thence North-east, following boundary line of said run to south-east corner of Run 295; thence Northerly, following eastern boundary of said run to a point on southern boundary line of Run 236; thence Easterly, along boundary line of Run 236 to the south-east corner of said run; and thence Northerly, along eastern boundary of said Run 236 to the north-east corner of same; thence Westerly, along boundary line of said run to commencing point: as the same is more par-

ticularly delineated on plan annexed, and coloured green.
