A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Taranaki Iron-Smelting Works Land Act, 1874." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Taranaki Iron-Smelting Works Land Act 1874 Amendment Act, 1883." Short Title.

10 2. The Waste Lands Board of Taranaki shall forthwith, after being requested by the New Zealand Titanic Steel and Iron Company (Limited) (herein referred to as "the company"), sell and dispose of the land described in the First and Second Schedules to "The Taranaki Iron-Smelting Works Land Act 1874 Amendment Act 1880" (herein referred to as "the said Act"), in the manner provided by section four of the said Act. Taranaki Land Board shall, at request of New Zealand Titanic Steel and Iron Company (Limited), dispose of land described in Schedules of "The Taranaki Iron Smelting Works Land Act 1874 Amendment Act, 1880," and pay proceeds to the Company, less costs of survey.

15 So much of the said land as is not so sold or disposed of at the expiration of three months from the making of the request by the company hereinbefore mentioned shall be sold by public auction by the Waste Lands Board of Taranaki, upon such terms and conditions as the New Zealand Titanic Steel and Iron Company (Limited) shall determine.

20 The Governor shall, upon the purchaser or purchasers carrying out the terms and conditions of the purchase, issue to the purchaser or purchasers a Crown grant or grants for the land so purchased under the provision aforesaid.

All moneys which shall arise from such sale or disposition as aforesaid shall, after deducting the costs of survey, be paid to the said New Zealand Titanic Steel and Iron Company (Limited).
