A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Grant to Henry Ferdinand Turner of Four Hundred Acres of Land in the Province of Taranaki. Title.

WHEREAS Henry Ferdinand Turner has been declared to be entitled to a grant from the Crown of four hundred acres of land, forming part of the confiscated lands now vested in the Crown, and situated in the Province of Taranaki: And whereas it is expedient to make provisions for granting the said land : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "Turner's Land Grant Act, 1870." Short Title.

2. Out of the confiscated lands in the Province of Taranaki, the said Henry Ferdinand Turner shall be at liberty to select a block of four hundred acres, in such reasonable form, having relation to the natural features of the same and of the lands adjacent thereto, as he shall think fit. Selection may be made from confiscated lands in Province of Taranaki.

3. The said Henry Ferdinand Turner shall, with all convenient speed, cause a survey to be made of the land so selected by him, and shall deliver a plan showing the boundaries and relative position of the same to the Colonial Secretary. To be surveyed, and plan delivered to Colonial Secretary.

4. Upon delivery to him of such plan as aforesaid, the said Colonial Secretary shall, if there be no reasonable objection to the form in which the said land has been selected, cause a grant from the Crown of the said land to be forthwith prepared and issued to the said Henry Ferdinand Turner. Crown Grant to be issued.
