A BILL INTITULED

An Act to set aside certain Lands in the Province of Title. Taranaki as Special Security under "The Provincial Loans Act, 1873."

WHEREAS by the fifty-first section of "The Provincial Loans Preamble.

Act, 1873," (hereinafter called "the said Act,") it is enacted that if by any Act of the General Assembly any land within any Province shall be set aside as a special security for a loan to be raised 5 for any one or more of the purposes in the said Act mentioned, the Legislature of such Province may, by Ordinance to be passed under the authority of the said Act, authorize such loan: And whereas it is expedient that land in the Province of Taranaki should be set aside as a special security for a loan to be raised for the purposes 10 hereinafter specified:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Taranaki Loan Land Short Title. 15 Security Act, 1873."

2. Out of the first one hundred and fifty thousand acres of land in the Power to set aside Province of Taranaki which, under the provisions of "The Confiscated 150,000 acres of land in Taranaki as a land and Lands Act. 1867" on "The Lands and Bublic Would had in Taranaki as a Lands Act, 1867," or "The Immigration and Public Works Act, in laraneal as a 1870," and the Acts amending the same, including "The Immigra- a loan.
20 tion and Public Works Act, 1873," shall become subject to be dealt with under the laws for the time being in force in the said Province regulating the sale occupation and disposal of the waste lands

of the Crown in the said Province, the Governor may by Proclamation

declare fifty thousand acres to be set aside as a special security for a 25 loan to be raised under the authority of an Ordinance to be passed by the Provincial Council of the Province of Taranaki, by virtue of the said Act, for the purposes specified in the First Schedule hereto. And also, a further block of fifty thousand acres to be set aside as a special security for a loan to be raised under the authority of an Ordinance to be passed by the Provincial Council aforesaid by virtue of the said Act for the purposes specified in the Second Schedule hereto. And upon No. 123-1.

the publication in the New Zealand Gazette of such Proclamation, the lands described therein shall be set aside as such security, and shall, for the purposes of the said Act, be deemed to be set aside by this Act

as such security.

If such Ordinance is not passed by the Provincial Council of such 5 Province, and assented to by the Governor, within two years from the publication of such Proclamation, the said Proclamation and this Act shall cease to have any operation, and the lands so set aside shall cease to be so set aside, as if such Proclamation had never been made.
