## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Trade Marks Act, 1866."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Trade Marks Act Amendment Short Title. Act, 1882."
- 5 2. The Registrar of Trade Marks may at any time after the issue of a Registrar may issue certificate under the fifth section of "The Trade Marks Act, 1866," issue a certified copies of certified copy of such certificate to any person applying for the same, and such registration. certified copy shall be admissible in evidence in like manner as the original certificate of which it is such certified copy.

A fee of ten shillings shall be paid to the Registrar in respect of the issue Fee to be paid 10 of every such certified copy by the person applying for the same.
