## A BILL INTITULED

**AN ACT to repeal clause XV. "Waste Lands Act 1858" so far as it affects the Province of Taranaki and also to repeal section VI. clauses XXXVII. XXXVIII. and XXXIX. of "The Regulations for the Sale and Disposal of the Waste Lands of the Crown within the Province of New Plymouth" proclaimed 20th October 1855 and confirmed by the said "Waste Lands Act 1858."**

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to repeal certain clauses in divers Waste Lands Acts and Regulations so far as they affect the Province of Taranaki

**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Taranaki Naval and Military Settlers' Act 1865."

II. Clause XV. of the said "Waste Lands Act 1858" as far as it affects the Province of Taranaki and section VI. clauses XXXVII. XXXVIII. and XXXIX. of "The Regulations for the Sale and Disposal of the Waste Lands of the Crown within the Province of New Plymouth" established by a Proclamation of Colonel Thomas Gore Browne dated twentieth October 1855 and confirmed by "The Waste Lands Act 1858" are hereby repealed.

III. This Act shall not affect any proceedings already undertaken or claims made under or in virtue of the abovementioned clause but the same may be completed and determined notwithstanding.

IV. This Act shall not come into operation until three months after Her Majesty's pleasure shall have been taken thereon and the same shall have been confirmed by Her Majesty with the advice of Her Privy Council and a Proclamation of such confirmation having been given shall have been made by the Governor and republished in the Government *Gazette* of the said Province.

V. The Colonial Secretary shall cause a copy of this Act if the same shall receive Her Majesty's assent to be published in the *United Service Gazette* newspaper in the City of London.
