A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to alter the Name of the Town of Raleigh, in the Province of Taranaki. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the name of the Town of Raleigh to the Native name of Waitara, by which it is generally known and designated: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Town of Waitara Act, 1870." Short Title.

2. From and after the thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, the town in the Province of Taranaki now called Raleigh shall be called Waitara. Name of Waitara substituted for Raleigh.

3. Whenever the name of Raleigh shall have been used before the coming into operation of this Act to designate the said Town of Raleigh, in any Act or Ordinance Crown Grant Proclamation Deed or other document public or private, it shall be taken to signify the said Town of Waitara. And to be so interpreted in Acts Deeds &c., heretofore made.
