A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Trustees Powers Delegation Act, 1869." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Trustees Powers Delegation Act 1869 Amendment Act, 1872." Short Title.
2. Every power of attorney or other delegation, by deed executed previous to the passing of "The Trustees Powers Delegation Act, 1869," by trustees out of the Colony of New Zealand, delegating to persons residing in the said Colony the exercise over property in the said Colony of the trusts or powers of sale exchange mortgage assignment and leasing, or any of them, vested in such trustees, and every sale conveyance exchange mortgage assignment and lease heretofore or hereafter executed under such power of attorney or other delegation, shall be and be deemed to have been as good valid and effectual at law and in equity as if the second section of "The Trustees Powers Delegation Act, 1869," had been in force at the time of the execution of such power of attorney or other delegation as aforesaid. Powers of attorney, &c., executed by trustees previous to the passing of "The Trustees Powers Delegation Act, 1869," declared valid.
