A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Taranaki Iron Smelting Works Land Act, 1874." Title.

WHEREAS "The New Zealand Titanic Steel and Iron Company (Limited)" have failed to comply with the conditions prescribed by "The Taranaki Iron Smelting Works Land Act, 1874," so as to entitle them to a grant of land as in the said Act mentioned: And whereas it is expedient to encourage further efforts to successfully smelt the Taranaki iron-sand by the said Company or their assigns: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Taranaki Smelting Works Land Act, 1877." Short Title.

2. If "The New Zealand Titanic Steel and Iron Company (Limited)," or their assigns, shall, before the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, have manufactured at their smelting works at New Plymouth, to the satisfaction of the Colonial Government, not less than one hundred tons of good marketable cast-iron, from Taranaki iron-sand, the said Company or their assigns shall be entitled to a Crown grant of the five thousand acres of land in the said Act mentioned, as though they had fully complied with all the conditions in the said Act prescribed. Company entitled to grant of land on smelting one hundred tons of iron.
