**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

- 1 Title**  
This Act is—  
(a) Te Ture Whenua Maori Amendment Act (No 2) **2007**; or  
(b) the Maori Land Amendment Act (No 2) **2007**.
- 2 Commencement** 5  
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

**This subpart** amends Te Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993.
- 19 Appointment of Judges**  
Section 7(4) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.

- 20 Appointment of temporary Judges**  
Section 9(5) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.
- 21 Tenure of office**  
Section 12(2) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”. 5
