A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Volunteers Land Act 1865
Amendment Act, 1873." Title.

WHEREAS "The Volunteers Land Act 1865 Amendment Act,
1873," provides that all claims for the exercise of scrip
issued under "The Volunteers Land Act, 1865," will be barred unless
made within twelve months after the passing of the said Amendment
5 Act: And whereas no waste lands of the Crown have been open for
sale within the Province of Taranaki in the purchase of which such
scrip could be exercised: And whereas it is expedient that provision
should be made for extending the period within which such scrip may
be exercised: Preamble.

10 **BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Volunteers Land
Act 1865 Amendment Act 1873 Amendment Act, 1874." Short Title.

15 2. Section three of "The Volunteers Land Act 1865 Amendment
Act, 1873," is hereby repealed so far as it affects the Province of
Taranaki. Repeal.

3. All claims for the exercise of scrip already issued under the
authority of "The Volunteers Land Act, 1865," will be barred unless
20 made within two years of the passing of this Act. Scrip to be exercised
within two years.

4. Such scrip may be exercised in the purchase of any land open
for sale under any law or regulation for the time being in force for
the disposal of the waste lands of the Crown within the said province. How scrip to be
exercised within
period named.
