A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Victoria University College Act, Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Victoria University Short Title. College Amendment Act, 1947, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Victoria Univer-

10 sity College Act, 1933 (hereinafter referred to as the 1933, No. 26 principal Act).

2. (1) Section five of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (h) of subsection two, and substituting the following new paragraph:—

"(h) Two members, being members of the Professorial Board, or if there is no Principal office, three such members, to be appointed by the Professorial Board: ".

(2) The member of the Council appointed by the Professorial Board and holding office on the passing of this Act shall continue in office until his retirement pursuant to subsection two of section six of the principal Act.

(3) The first additional member of the Council to be appointed by the Professorial Board by virtue of this section shall be appointed not later than the third Monday in June in the year nineteen hundred and forty-eight, and shall hold office until the expiry of the term 10 of office of the other member appointed by the Professorial Board and holding office on the passing of this Act.

(4) Section five of the principal Act is hereby further consequentially amended as follows:—

(a) By omitting from subsection three the words "other member", and substituting the words "other members":

(b) By omitting from subsection four the words "two other persons", and substituting the 20 words "three other persons":

(c) By omitting from the said subsection four the words "neither of them", and substituting the words "none of them".

3. (1) Subsection two of section five of the principal **25** Act is hereby further amended by inserting, after paragraph (h), as set out in subsection one of section two of this Act, the following new paragraph:—

"(hh) One member (hereinafter referred to as the representative of the teaching staff), 30 being a member of the teaching staff of the College, to be elected by the members of that staff:".

(2) For the purposes of this section and of the principal Act the expression "the teaching staff" 35 means the professors of the College, together with such of the full-time lecturers of the College as are for the time being entitled, pursuant to section forty-seven of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1944, to vote, as lecturers, at elections of members of the Academic Board of the 40 University of New Zealand.

(3) The election of the first member of the Council to be elected by members of the teaching staff shall be held not later than the first Monday in June in the year nineteen hundred and forty-eight, and the member 5 so elected shall retire from office in the year nineteen hundred and forty-nine.

4. (1) Subsection two of section six of the principal Consequential Act, as amended by subsection two of section sixty of amendments of principal Act the Statutes Amendment Act, 1938, is hereby further 10 amended by omitting the expression "(h), and (j)", and substituting the expression "(h), (hh), and (j)".

(2) Subsection one of section seven of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding thereto the words "or the representative of the teaching staff".

(3) Subsection one of section nine of the principal 15 Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (g), the following new paragraph:—

> "(qq) Being the representative of the teaching staff, ceases to be a member of the teaching staff; or ".

(4) Subsection two of section sixty of the Statutes Repeal. Amendment Act, 1938, is hereby repealed.
