WHANGAREI ABATTOIR-SITE AMENDMENT EXTENSION.

[LOCAL BILL.]

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable the Borough Council of Whangarei to acquire a Portion of the Whangarei Public Cemetery in order to extend the Abattoir-site.

Title.

5 WHEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of the Cemeteries Act, 1908, and its amendments the Whangarei Borough Council is a local authority in whom is vested the control and management of the public cemetery described in the *First* Schedule hereto: And whereas it has become necessary for the Whangarei Borough Council to extend its abattoir-site, and a portion of the said public cemetery has, with the consent and concurrence of the Whangarei Borough Council, as Trustees of the said public cemetery, been selected as a most suitable place for such purposes, and the same has been surveyed, and is described in the *Second* Schedule hereto:

Preamble.

15 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Whangarei Abattoir-site Amendment *Extension* Act, 1928.

Short Title.

20 *New.*

1A. The Governor-General may by Order in Council cancel the reservation as a public cemetery over the land described in the *Second* Schedule hereto, and may, in the same or in a subsequent Order in Council, declare the land so described to be vested in the corporation of the Borough of Whangarei as a site for a public abattoir for the said Borough.

Reservation of land as a cemetery may be cancelled and land vested as an abattoir-site.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor-General upon the passing of this Act, by notification in the *Gazette*, to declare that all that piece or parcel of land described in the *Second Schedule* hereto shall, from the date of publication of such notification, be no longer required for the purposes of a public cemetery.

3. The Governor-General may, after the publication of the notification in terms of the *last preceding* section hereof, issue a Crown grant or certificate of title, as the case may require, in fee-simple for the land described in the said *Second Schedule* to and in favour of the body corporate called "The Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Whangarei" in trust as a site for abattoir purposes for the said borough.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, being part Section 1 of Block XVI, Purua Survey District, ~~described in the First Schedule hereto~~, and containing by admeasurement 32 acres and 16 perches, more or less, bounded as follows: Commencing at the north-west corner of ~~Original~~ Section 1 aforesaid, towards the north and east by original boundaries of said Section 1, 2847 links bearing 88° 29' and 835.2 links bearing 178° 29'; towards the south-east by Section 1A, 1522 links bearing 251° 15' 30" and 968 links bearing 254° 05' 30"; towards the south-west by the Great North Road 1592.1 links bearing 341° 57'; to the point of commencement: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, being part Section 1 of Block XVI, Purua Survey District, described in the First Schedule hereto, and containing by admeasurement 25 acres and 15.6 perches, more or less, bounded as follows: Commencing at the north-west corner of ~~Original~~ Section 1 aforesaid; towards the north and east by original boundaries of said Section 1, 2847 links bearing 88° 29' and 835.2 links bearing 178° 29'; towards the south-east by Section 1A, 1522 links bearing 251° 15' 30" and 968 links bearing 254° 05' 30"; towards the south-west by the Great North Road, 30.6 links bearing 341° 57'; towards the north-west, south-west, and south-east by other part of said Section 1, 971.2 links bearing 74° 09' 30", 717.4 links bearing 344° 08' and 997.8 links bearing 253° 08' 30"; towards the south-west by the Great North Road 861.3 links bearing 341° 57'; to the point of commencement: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.
