A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend "The Westland and Nelson Coalfields Administration Act, 1877." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Westland and Nelson Coalfields Administration Act, 1901"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Westland and Nelson Coalfields Administration Act, 1877" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"). Short Title.

2. The parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to form part of the Third Schedule to the principal Act, and shall be administered accordingly. Endowment for Westport Harbour Board.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that parcel of land in the County of Buller, in the Provincial District of Nelson, containing by admeasurement 273 acres, more or less. Bounded on the north by the sea from the Buller River to a line due north from the point of intersection of the north side of Bright Street and west side of Domett Street: towards the east by the line aforesaid: towards the south by the north side of Bright Street from the west side of Domett Street to the east side of Palmerston Street; thence along the east side of Palmerston Street in a north-westerly direction to the north side of Kennedy Street; and thence along the north side of Kennedy Street to the Buller River: and towards the west by the Buller River aforesaid; excluding Education Reserve Sections 88 and 111, Native Reserve Sections 109 and 110, and freehold Sections 924, 925, and 953: all as delineated in map prepared by the Westport Harbour Board, dated the 9th day of April, 1901, and signed by R. A. Young, Assoc.M.Inst.C.E., engineer to the said Westport Harbour Board, and a duly authorised surveyor.
