A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Borough Council of the Borough of Wanganui Title. to make and levy a Special Rate on all Rateable Property in the said Borough for the Purpose of the Repayment of various Loans and the Interest thereon, to validate the Raising of and certain Payments made, Steps taken, and Acts done, and to give certain Powers in connection with certain Loans to authorize the Purchase of the Undertaking of the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board.

WHEREAS by Proclamation of His Excellency the Governor-General Preamble. 10 of the Dominion of New Zealand, made pursuant to the provisions in that behalf contained in the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, on the twenty-fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the twenty-seventh day of

March, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, number seventeen, at page 15 seven hundred and thirty-four, the districts of the Borough of Wanganui and the Town Boards of Gonville and Castlecliff, duly constituted under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, and the Town Boards Act, 1908, respectively, were constituted one united borough as and from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-four,

20 under the name of the Borough of Wanganui: And whereas the boundaries of the said Borough of Wanganui so constituted as aforesaid are set out in the Schedule to the said Proclamation: And whereas the Council of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted prior to the said Proclamation had, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the

statutes then in force, raised various special loans, the amounts whereof, the special rates made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the rating-areas affected thereby, are particularly set out in the First Schedule hereto: And whereas the Town Board of the Gonville Town Board District as constituted prior to the said Proclamation had, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the statutes then in force, raised various special loans, the amounts whereof, the special rates made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the rating-areas affected thereby, are particularly set out in the Second Schedule hereto: 10 And whereas the Town Board of the Castlecliff Town Board District as constituted prior to the said Proclamation had, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the statutes then in force, raised various special loans, the amounts whereof, the special rates made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the 15 rating-areas affected thereby, are particularly set out in the Third Schedule hereto: And whereas, of the special loans raised by the Council of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted prior to the said Proclamation, the One hundred and forty thousand Pounds Tramways Loan mentioned in the First Schedule hereto was raised for the 20 separate purposes, and with the separate amounts allocated to each separate purpose, as specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto: And whereas the proposal to raise the said loan upon which a poll of the ratepayers of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted prior to the said Proclamation was duly taken contained a statement, in accordance 25 with the statutes then in force, that it was proposed to pay the first year's interest on the loan, the cost of the loan, and the sinking fund for the first year out of the loan: And whereas in determining the amount of the said loan no provision was made by the Council of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted prior to the said Proclamation 30 for the payment out of the loan-moneys of such interest, cost, and sinking fund: And whereas the Council of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted prior to the said Proclamation raised, pursuant to section eighteen of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Fourteen thousand Pounds Tramways Loan mentioned in the First Schedule 36 hereto for the purpose of completing the works specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto, the loan-moneys originally authorized having been found insufficient to complete such works: And whereas the whole of the loan-moneys allocated to several of the separate purposes mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto have been expended in or towards 40 the completion of such purposes, and no provision has been made for payment thereout of the proportionate part of the first year's interest on the loan and the sinking fund for the first year properly chargeable thereto: And whereas it is expedient that the raising of the Fourteen thousand Pounds Tramways Loan mentioned in the First Schedule 45 hereto, and all payments made, acts done, and steps taken in connection with or relating to the One hundred and forty thousand Pounds Tramways Loan and the Fourteen thousand Pounds Tramways Loan be And whereas the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board, a Board duly constituted under the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway 50 District Act, 1908 (Local), duly constructed and is maintaining and working a tramway within the meaning of the Tramways Act, 1908,

over portion of the district of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted by the said Proclamation: And whereas the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the statutes then in force, raised various special loans, the amounts whereof, the special rates made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the rating-areas affected thereby, are particularly set out in the Fifth Schedule hereto: And whereas the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board has agreed to sell all that its "undertaking" within the meaning given to that word by the Tram-10 ways Act, 1908, and all other its property and assets, to the Council of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted by the said Proclamation as at the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and the Council of the Borough of Wanganui has agreed to purchase the same, upon the terms that the Council of the Borough of Wanganui shall pay 15 and discharge the debts and liabilities of the said Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board as existing at the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and as set out in the Sixth Schedule hereto, and the various loans as set out in the Fifth Schedule hereto: And whereas it is expedient in the interests of the Borough of Wanganui as 20 constituted by the said Proclamation that one special rate providing for the payment of the sinking funds established in respect of the various loans raised prior to the said Proclamation, and the interest payable on such special loans, and providing for the repayment of such of the said special loans and the interest thereon as have been raised in terms of the 25 New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, or the State Advances Act, 1913, by the periodical payments provided by those Acts, and providing for the payment of the sinking funds established in respect of the loans raised by the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board, and the interest payable on such special loans, shall be made 30 and levied upon all rateable property within the Borough of Wanganui as constituted at the time of the making and levying of such special rate, and that the various objects, powers, and authorities hereby sought should be given effect to by legislation:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 35 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

1. This Act may be cited as the Wanganui Borough Council Special Short Title.

Rate Empowering and Enabling Act, 1924.

2. "The Wanganui Borough" shall mean the Mayor, Councillors, Interpretation. 40 and Burgesses of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, the area whereof is defined by Proclamation of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand of the twenty-fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the twenty-45 seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, number seventeen, at page seven hundred and thirty-four.

"Council" means the Borough Council of the Borough of Wanganui.

"Board" means the Gonville and Castlecliff Tramway Board.

3. The Council may, for the purpose of providing for the payment Power to levy special 50 of the sinking funds established in respect of the loans enumerated in rate. the First, Second, Third, and Fifth Schedules to this Act, and the payment of interest on such loans, and for the purpose of providing

for the payment of such of the loans and the interest thereon as have been raised in terms of the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, or the State Advances Act, 1913, by the periodical payments as provided by those Acts, make and levy a special rate upon all the rateable property (on the basis of the annual value thereof) of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted at the time of the making or levying of such rate.

Rates not to be levied.

Application of moneys raised by

special rate.

4. From and after the passing of this Act it shall not be necessary for the Council to levy or collect the special rates made for the purposes of providing for the payment of the loans or the interest thereon 10 enumerated in the *First*, *Second*, *Third*, and *Fifth* Schedules to this Act.

5. The Council shall, out of the moneys raised by the making and levying of the said special rate, pay—

(a.) The interest from time to time payable in respect of the said loans:

(b.) The amount payable from time to time to the Commissioners of the Sinking Funds established or to be established in respect of the said loans; and

(c.) The periodical payments of principal and interest payable in respect of such of the said loans as are payable to the New 20 Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Department.

6. The provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, and the Rating Act, 1908 (relating to special rates) are incorporated herewith.

7. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of the holders of 25 debentures issued in respect of any of the said loans.

8. The raising by the Council of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted prior to the issue of the said Proclamation of the twenty-fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, of the Fourteen thousand Pounds Tramways Loan mentioned in the First Schedule 30 hereto, known as "The Wanganui Borough Council Tramway Additional Loan of Fourteen thousand Pounds," and all payments made, steps taken, and acts done in connection with or in any way relating to the said loan, or the One hundred and forty thousand Pounds Tramways Loan mentioned in the First Schedule, known as "The Wanganui 35 Borough Council Tramways Special Loan of One hundred and forty thousand Pounds," are, notwithstanding the provisions of any Act to the contrary, hereby validated and declared to have been lawfully made, taken, and done.

Validating raising of loan and certain payments made, steps taken, and acts done by the Council.

Power to apply loanmoneys generally. 9. Notwithstanding the provisions of any Act or Acts to the contrary, and notwithstanding the allocation of the specified sums to the separate purposes of the One hundred and forty thousand Pounds Tramways Loan, known as "The Wanganui Borough Council Tramways Special Loan of One hundred and forty thousand Pounds," as shown in the Fourth Schedule hereto, the said loan shall be deemed to be a loan raised, and it is hereby declared to have been raised, for the extension of the tramway system in the Borough of Wanganui, and the supply and reticulation of electric current for lighting and power generally; and the Council may and it is hereby expressly authorized and empowered to pay, apply, use, and allocate the moneys of the said loan accordingly as if no specified sums had been allocated to the separate purposes of the loan.

10. The Board and the Council are hereby expressly authorized Power to acquire the and empowered, without giving the notices or obtaining the consents undertaking, &c., of the Gonville and required by the Tramways Act. 1908, to respectively sell and purchase, Castleeliff Tramway upon the terms of the Council paying and discharging the liabilities of the Board as set out in the Sixth Schedule hereto, and paying or discharging or otherwise making provision for the payment of the special loans set out in the Fifth Schedule hereto at the maturity thereof, the "undertaking" (within the meaning given to that word by the Tramways Act, 1908), the lands particularly described in the Seventh 10 Schedule hereto, and all other property and assets of the Board; and the Council may and it is hereby expressly authorized and empowered to and shall pay and discharge such liabilities, and pay and discharge or otherwise make provision for the payment of the said special loans.

11. The purchase by the Council of the said undertaking, lands, Date of completion 15 and other property and assets shall be deemed to have been made and of purchase. completed on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and as from that date the said undertaking, lands, and other property and assets shall vest and be deemed to have vested in and become the absolute property of the Council of the Borough of Wanganui.

20 12. For the purpose of paying and discharging the liabilities set Power to borrow. out in the Sixth Schedule hereto the Council may, and it is hereby expressly authorized and empowered,—

(a.) To borrow the amount of such liabilities, on such terms as will produce to the lender a rate of interest not exceeding six pounds per centum per annum, in terms of and pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913:

(b.) To pay the amount of the said liabilities out of its General Account.

13. The said lands particularly described in the Seventh Schedule Vesting lands in 30 hereto shall, as from the said first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, vest and be deemed to have vested in the Wanganui Borough for an estate in fee-simple for municipal purposes. No stamp duty or other duty shall be chargeable upon any conveyance, transfer, or other assurance executed for the purpose of so vesting the said lands. 35

Corporation.

14. (1.) On the presentation to him of a petition from the Board Abolition of Board's praying for the abolition of the district of the Board the Governor-General may by Proclamation abolish the said district and declare the Board to be dissolved as from a date to be specified in such

district.

Dissolving of Board.

(2.) Nothing in this section shall relieve the ratepayers for the time being in the said district affected from their liability to pay any special rate made by the Board as security for any loan:

Provided always that the Council, and it is hereby expressly authorized so to do, shall indemnify and at all times hereafter keep indemnified any such ratepayer from all liability to pay any such special rate heretofore made by the Board, and from all actions, proceedings, costs, damages, expenses, claims, and demands whatsoever in respect thereof.

(3.) For the purpose of levying and collecting any such special rate the Council shall have and may exercise all the powers that would have been exercisable in respect thereof by the Board if the said district had not been abolished.
