WANGANUI BOROUGH COUNCIL SPECIAL RATE EMPOWERING AND SPECIAL LOAN.

[LOCAL BILL.]

ANALYSIS.

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A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorize the Borough Council of the Borough of Title. Wanganui to make and levy a Special Rate on all Rateable Property in the said Borough for the Purpose of the Repayment of various Loans and the Interest thereon, and to raise various Moneys by Special Order.

WHEREAS by Proclamation of His Excellency the Governor made Preamble. pursuant to paragraph (d) of section one hundred and twenty of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908, on the nineteenth day of December. 10 nineteen hundred and twelve, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and twelve, No. 92. at page 3617, the Corporations of the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Wanganui and the Borough of Wanganui East, boroughs duly constituted under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908. 15 were constituted one borough as and from the first day of January, nineteen hundred and thirteen, under the name of the Borough of Wanganui: And whereas the Council of the Borough of Wanganui. as constituted prior to the said Proclamation, had, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the Statutes then in force, raised various special 20 loans, the amounts whereof, the special rates made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the rating-

areas affected thereby are particularly set out in the First Schedule hereto: And whereas the Council of the Borough of Wanganui East, as constituted prior to the said Proclamation, had, pursuant to the

25 powers vested in it by the Statutes then in force, raised various special

loans, the amounts whereof, the special rates made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the ratingareas affected thereby are particularly set out in the Second Schedule hereto: And whereas since the making of the said Proclamation the Council of the Borough of Wanganui authorized the raising of a certain special loan, the amount whereof, the special rate to be made and levied for the repayment thereof, and the interest and charges thereon, and the rating-area affected thereby are particularly set out in the Third Schedule hereto; and at a poll of the ratepayers of the special-rating area affected thereby, held on the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred 10 and thirteen, the proposal to raise such loan was duly carried: And whereas it is expedient in the interests of the Borough of Wanganui, as constituted by the said Proclamation, that one special rate providing for the payment of the sinking funds established in respect of the various loans raised prior to the said Proclamation, and the interest payable 15 on such special loans, and providing for the repayment of such of the said special loans and the interest thereon as have been raised in terms of the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, by the periodical payments provided by that Act, and providing for the payment of the sinking fund to be established in respect of the loan mentioned 20 in the Third Schedule hereto, and the interest and other charges payable thereon, shall be made and levied upon all rateable property within the Borough of Wanganui as constituted at the time of the making and levying of such special rate: And whereas the Borough of Wanganui, as constituted prior to the said Proclamation, constructed, provided, or 25 established certain works or undertakings within the meaning of the words "public work" or "undertaking" as defined by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and paid for the same by overdraft on the bankers of the said borough; and such overdraft in connection with such works or undertakings now amounts to the sum of ten thousand one hundred 30 and eighty-three pounds nine shillings and fivepence: And whereas it is expedient in the interests of the said borough that a special loan should be raised for the purpose of paying off such overdraft:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 35 as follows:—

Short Title.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Wanganui Borough Council Special Rate Empowering and Special Loan Act, 1913.
 - "The Wanganui Borough" shall mean the Mayor, Councillors, 40 and Burgesses of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908, the area whereof is defined by Proclamation of His Excellency the Governor of the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and twelve, and published in the New Zealand 45 Gazette, nineteen hundred and twelve, No. 92, at page
 - "Council" means the Borough Council of the Borough of Wanganui,

3. The Council may, for the purpose of providing for the payment Power to levy of the sinking funds established in respect of the loans enumerated in the First and Second Schedules to this Act, and the payment of interest on such loans, and for the purpose of providing for the payment of such of the loans and the interest thereon as have been raised in terms of the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, by the periodical payments as provided by that Act, and for the purpose of providing for the payment of the sinking fund to be established in respect of the loan mentioned in the Third Schedule to this Act, and the 10 payment of interest and other charges thereon, make and levy a special rate upon all the rateable property (on the basis of the annual value thereof) of the Borough of Wanganui as constituted at the time of the making or levying of such rate.

4. From and after the passing of this Act it shall not be necessary Rates not to be 15 for the Council to levy or collect the special rates made for the purposes of providing for the payment of the loans or the interest thereon enumerated in the First and Second Schedules to this Act.

5. The Council shall, out of the moneys raised by the making and Application of levying of the said special rate, pay—

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moneys raised by special rate.

(a.) The interest from time to time payable in respect of the said

(b.) The amount payable from time to time to the Commissioners of the sinking funds established or to be established in respect of the said loans; and

(c.) The periodical payments of principal and interest payable in respect of such of the said loans as are payable to the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Department.

6. The provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, the Muni- Acts incorporated. cipal Corporations Act, 1908, and the Rating Act, 1908 (relating to 30 special rates), are incorporated herewith.

7. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of the holders of Rights of debentures issued in respect of any of the said loans.

debenture-holders not affected.

8. The Council may raise a special loan by special order, and Power to borrow. without taking the steps described in sections seven to thirteen of the 35 Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, for the purpose of paying off the said sum of ten thousand one hundred and eighty-three pounds nine shillings and fivepence.

9. Nothing in this Act contained shall affect or be deemed to affect Borrowing-powers the rights of the Council to borrow or raise by way of special loan moneys under Municipal Corporations Act, 40 for the purpose of clearing off any overdraft conferred or authorized 1908, not affected. by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908, or any amendment thereof, but the powers by this Act conferred shall be in addition to, and not in substitution for, the powers thereby conferred.

10. "Special order" means a special order within the meaning Definition of 45 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908.
