A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Whangarei Borough Empowering Act, 1918. Title.

WHEREAS the Whangarei Borough Council was authorized by the Preamble.
5 Whangarei Borough Empowering Act, 1918, to raise certain loans for the purpose of the formation and construction of certain private streets within such borough: And whereas in the public notice of the poll taken for the purpose of raising such loans and which loans were duly raised the sum of one thousand three hundred and twenty
10 pounds was stated as required for Raumanga Road, one of the streets named as a private street in such Act: And whereas Raumanga Road is, and was at the time of the passing of such Act, a public street, and such loan is not now required for the purpose of forming and metalling such street, as such street has now been formed and
15 metalled as a public street: And whereas it has been found that the moneys allocated for the purpose of forming and metalling the other private streets named in such Act are insufficient, and it is necessary to give power to the Whangarei Borough Council to apply such moneys towards the construction of such other private streets.

20 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Whangarei Borough Empowering Amendment Act, 1922. Short Title.

25 2. The Whangarei Borough Council is hereby empowered to expend moneys raised in respect of Raumanga Road aforesaid on such of the said other private streets as may be requisite, together with all powers in respect thereof as so expended as may be requisite for the purpose of creating separate or special rating areas and
30 levying rates in respect thereof as provided in such Act *mutatis mutandis*. Power to expend money raised for Raumanga Road on certain private streets.
