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A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower the Council of the City of Wellington to make certain Alterations in the Basin Reserve and in Streets in the Vicinity thereof. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Wellington Basin Reserve Act, 1900." Short Title.

10 2. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context,— Interpretation.
"City" means the City of Wellington;
"Council" means the Council of the City of Wellington;
"Corporation" means the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Wellington.

15 3. The part of the Basin Reserve, situate in the city, described in the *First* Schedule hereto, is hereby declared to be a public street of the city. The Council is hereby empowered to lay, maintain, and use any tramway-lines upon the same street. New street through Basin Reserve.

20 4. It shall be lawful for the Council to close so much of the street called Sussex Square as is described in the *Second* Schedule hereto, and to add the area thereof to the said Basin Reserve. Part of Sussex Square to be closed.

25 5. It shall be lawful for the Council to purchase or to take, under the provisions of "The Public Works Act, 1894," the land described in the *Third* Schedule hereto, and to add the same to the said Basin Reserve. Additional area may be taken for Basin Reserve.

6. The areas added to the Basin Reserve under sections *four* and *five* shall be deemed parts thereof, and shall be held by the Corporation on the same trusts and with the same powers as those upon and with which the Basin Reserve is now held. New areas to form part of Basin Reserve.

Power to lease or
sell.

7. It shall be lawful for the Corporation to lease, under the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," or of "The Public Bodies' Powers Act, 1887," or to sell by public auction or public tender all or any part or parts of the Basin Reserve lying to the west of the said new street, and described in the first part of the *Fourth* Schedule hereto, and all or any part or parts of such portion of the said land included in the said *Third* Schedule as is described in the second part of the *Fourth* Schedule hereto.

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Power to continue
Brougham Street.

8. It shall be lawful for the Corporation to purchase or take under the provisions of "The Public Works Act, 1894," the land described in the *Fifth* Schedule hereto, and to lay out the same as a public street in continuation of Brougham Street.

9. This Act shall be deemed a special Act within the meaning of "The Public Works Act, 1894."

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

PROPOSED NEW ROAD THROUGH THE RESERVE.

COMMENCING at Buckle Street on the north, and terminating at Dock Street on the south, being a length of 585 ft. or thereabouts, and 70 ft. in width, and as shown in red colour upon the deposited plan, bounded on the west by that part of the Basin Reserve lying west of a line drawn from the point of intersection of the west side of Cambridge Terrace and the north side of Buckle Street to a point on the north side of Dock Street at its intersection with the line of the west side of Adelaide Road, produced.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ROAD TO BE CLOSED AND INCLUDED IN THE RESERVE EXTENSION.

So much of Sussex Square East as is coloured round in green upon the deposited plan, and being of the full width of 66 ft., and in length from north to south 432 ft. or thereabouts; bounded on the east by Town Acres 670, 669, and 668, and by a part, 40 ft. in length, of Town Acre 667, immediately adjoining 668, and upon the west by the present reserve.

Also, a further portion of Sussex Square East, coloured round green on deposited plan, and marked "A" thereon, being of the length from north to south of 80 ft. or thereabouts, and of the average width of 33 ft. or thereabouts; bounded on the north by Buckle Street, on the south by that portion of Sussex Square East herein last described, on the east by that portion of Sussex Square East to be retained as a street, and on the west and south-west by the present reserve.

Also, a further portion of Sussex Square East, coloured round green on deposited plan, and marked "B" thereon, being of the length from north to south of 68 ft. or thereabouts, and of the average width of 33 ft. or thereabouts; bounded on the north by that portion of Sussex Square East hereinbefore described, on the south by Dock Street, on the east by that portion of Sussex Square East to be retained as a street, and upon the west and north-west by the present reserve.

THIRD SCHEDULE.

LANDS TO BE ACQUIRED.

Town Acres Nos. 670, 669, and 668, together with all the buildings and appurtenances thereupon; bounded on the north by Town Acre 667, on the south by Town Acre 671, on the east by Brougham Street and so much of its proposed extension immediately adjoining thereto and hereinafter defined in the *Fifth* Schedule, and on the west by Sussex Square East.

Also that portion of Town Acre 667, together with all the buildings and appurtenances thereupon, immediately adjoining Town Acre 668, having a frontage to Sussex Square East of 40 ft. or thereabouts, and a depth from east to west of 100 ft. or thereabouts.

FOURTH SCHEDULE.

LANDS PROPOSED TO BE SOLD OR LEASED.

Part I.—That portion of the Basin Reserve lying to the west of the proposed new road defined in the First Schedule, and coloured round in blue upon the deposited plan; bounded on the north by Buckle Street, on the south by Dock Street, on the east by the proposed new road aforesaid, and on the west by Sussex Square.

Part II.—That portion of Town Acres 670, 669, and 668 coloured round in blue upon the deposited plan, and being in length from north to south 385 ft. or thereabouts, and in width from east to west 100 ft. or thereabouts; bounded on the north by Town Acre 667, and on the south by Town Acre 671, on the east by Brougham Street and its proposed extension hereinafter defined in the Fifth Schedule, and on the west by the remaining portions of Town Acres 670, 669, and 668.

FIFTH SCHEDULE.

PROPOSED EXTENSION OF BROUGHAM STREET.

COMMENCING at the present southern termination of Brougham Street, opposite the southern boundary of Town Acre 668, and running in a southerly direction over and upon the Wellington College Reserve for a distance of 382 ft. or thereabouts, terminating at the southern boundary of Town Acre 671, and being of the width of 49 ft. 6in., and as shown in red colour upon the deposited plan; bounded on the east by the College Reserve, and upon the west by Town Acres 669, 670, and 671.
