A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Wellington College Act, Title. 1872."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wellington College Short Title. Act 1872 Amendment Act, 1877."

2. Sir William Fitzherbert, K.C.M.G., and William Waring Governors of College. Taylor, Esquire, shall be Governors of the College until the expiration of ten years from the passing of "The Wellington College Act, 1872,"

subject to the provisions thereof. 3. The members of the House of Representatives for the City of Members for Wel-Wellington for the time being shall be Governors of the College lington, Governors ex officio. 10 ex officio.

Clauses 4, 5, and 6, and Schedule erased.
4. In case the said Sir William Fitzherbert, K.C.M.G., and Vacancies how filled William Waring Taylor, Esquire, or any of the present Governors appointed by the late Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, shall cease to be a Governor of the College, the Governor shall appoint a person or persons to be a Governor or Governors, in the place of the person or persons who shall have ceased to be a Governor or Governors.

Power to lease.

5. The Governors shall have power with respect to the lands described in the Schedule hereto to manage and deal with the same as they may think fit, and from time to time to let the same or any part thereof for any term not exceeding forty-two years in possession from the date of the lease thereof, and by auction, at such rent and on such conditions as they shall think fit, but so that no fine, foregift, or premium be taken.

6. Section thirteen of "The Wellington College Act, 1872," is hereby repealed in so far as is inconsistent with this Act.

DESCRIPTION OF PORTIONS OF COLLEGE RESERVE SUBDIVIDED INTO BUILDING SITES FOR LEASE, AS PER ACCOMPANYING PLAN.

Is bounded on the West by Town Sections 742, 743, 744, and 745, 1507 links, bearing 178° 25'; on the South by other portion of reserve, commencing at south-east corner of Section 745, 577 links, bearing 83° 47'; on the East by the College Grounds, 650 links north-west and 563 links north to south-east corner of Town Section 678; on the North by Town Section No. 678, 232 links, bearing 278° 27.

Portion No. 2, consisting of Lots 1 to 11 included, containing 16 acres, including roads. New clause.

4. Whenever any Governor of the College, not being an *ex officio* Governor thereof, shall cease to be such Governor, the Governor in Council shall from time to time appoint a person to be a Governor thereof in place of the person so ceasing to be Governor.
