A BILL INTITULED

An Act to enable the Governors of the Wellington College and Title. Girls' High School to convey to the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Wellington a certain Piece of Land for the Purpose of widening a Street in the said City called College Lane, and to enable the said Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens to convey to the said Governors another Piece of Land in exchange therefor.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 10 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Wellington Corporation Short Title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governors of the Wellington College and Girls' High School to convey to the Mayor, Councillors, and Governors may 15 citizens of the City of Wellington, in exchange for the piece of land convey land to Corporation. described in the Second Schedule hereto, the piece of land described in the First Schedule hereto; to be held by the Corporation for the purpose of widening a street in the said city called College Lane.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

A PARCEL of land situate in the City of Wellington, being the part of Lot No. 6 of Sir George Grey's Reclamation, vested in the said Governors, and a parcel of land in the same city, being Lot No. 24 on the plan deposited in the Lands Registry Office, and there numbered 331; the land comprising which two parcels is bounded on the south by College Lane for 200ft.; on the east by Victoria Street, 25ft.; on the west by Willis Street, 25ft.; and on the north by other part of the said Lot No. 6 and by Lot No. 23 on the said deposited plan.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

A PARCEL of land situate in the said city, being part of the lands comprised in Lots Nos. 28 and 29 either the whole of Lot 28 and a portion of Lot 29 or a part of Lot 29 on the said deposited plan, and having a frontage to Victoria Street of 75ft., with a depth equal to that of the said lands; such parcel to be selected by the said Governors in one plot, and to commence either from the north-east corner of Lot No. 29 or from the north-west corner of Lot No. 28, the side line to be drawn parallel to the eastern boundary of Lot No. 29 or to the western boundary of Lot No. 28, as the ease selection may be made.
