COMMENCING northerly at the point of junction of the Taranaki, Waitotara, and Patea Counties, near the eastern corner of the Mangaotuku Block; bounded thence towards the east and south-easterly by the County of Waitotara to the ocean; thence towards the south-westerly by Cook Strait to the mouth-of-the Whenuakura River; thence northerly towards the north-west by the centre a line along the middle of that river to the point where it is intersected by the confiscated boundary-line; and thence northerly by a direct line from said point of intersection to commencing-point.
