A BILL INTITLED

AN ACT to constitute the Woodville County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Woodville County Act, 1901."

Short Title.

2. The Woodville County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise that portion of the Waipawa County particularly described in the Schedule hereto; and the boundaries of the Waipawa County are hereby altered accordingly.

Constitution of Woodville County.

3. From and after the coming into operation of this Act, and during the existence of the county hereby constituted, no local body or authority other than the County Council shall, within the limits of the said county, exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under the provisions of "The Counties Act, 1886," or any amendment thereof, or otherwise.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that area in the Hawke's Bay Land District bounded towards the north-east generally by Tamaki No. 4 Block to its intersection with the Mangapukakakahu Stream; thence by the said Mangapukakakahu Stream to its junction with the Oruakeretaki Stream; thence by the said Oruakeretaki Stream to the Manawatu River; thence on the east generally by the said Manawatu River, and crossing the said Manawatu River to its junction with the Otope Stream; thence generally on the north and east by the said Otope Stream to its intersection with the southern boundary of Kaitoki No. 3 Block; thence again on the north and east generally by the said southern boundary of Kaitoki No. 3 Block and the western boundaries of Mangatoro Nos. 1, 2, and 3 Blocks; thence on the north-east by the south-western boundary of Mangatoro No. 2 Block to its intersection with the north-western boundary of Puketoi No. 6B Block; thence on the south-east generally by the Puketoi No. 6B and 6A Blocks to the boundary between the Waipawa and Pahiatua Counties; thence on the south and south-west generally by the Pahiatua County as described in the Schedule to "The Counties Act Amendment Act, 1888"; and thence on the north-west by the Pohangina County as described in the Schedule to "The Pohangina County Act, 1894."
