A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute the Weber County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Weber County Act, 1902." Short Title.

2. The Weber Road District is hereby abolished, and in lieu thereof the Weber County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise all that portion of the original Patangata County which at the date of the passing of this Act was comprised within the Weber Road District, and which is particularly described in the Schedule hereto. The boundaries of the said Patangata County are hereby altered accordingly, and the said Weber Road District shall be deemed to be merged in the Weber County hereby constituted. Weber Road District abolished and Weber County constituted.

3. From and after the coming into operation of this Act, and during the existence of the county hereby constituted, no local body or authority other than the County Council shall, within the limits of the said county, exercise any jurisdiction or authority over any roads, or over or in relation to any matter or thing in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon a County Council under the provisions of "The Counties Act, 1886," or any amendment thereof, or otherwise. Schedule.

ALL that area of land in the Land District of Hawke's Bay bounded towards the south-west by the Wairarapa North County from the mouth of the Waimata Stream to Trig. Station No. 52c, Wahataura; towards the north-west by the Puketoi No. 6 and the Mangatoro Blocks; towards the north-east by the Manawakaitoi, Manawaangiangi, and the Mangamaire Blocks; and towards the east by Blocks Nos. 58, 82, 85, 62, 65, 68, 81, 84, 79, 75, 27, 86, 83, the Pakuka Stream, Block 5, and the sea, to the starting-point.
