## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Land in the Waiapu County Council, acting as a Harbour Board in respect of the Harbour at Tokomaru Bay. Title.

5 WHEREAS it is desired to vest the land described in the Schedule hereto in the Waiapu County Council, acting as a Harbour Board in respect of the Harbour of Tokomaru Bay, in the County of Waiapu, to be used for an endowment for the said harbour: Preamble.

10 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Waiapu County Council (Tokomaru Harbour Endowment) Act, 1911. Short Title.

15 2. The lands described in the Schedule hereto are hereby vested in the Waiapu County Council as an endowment for the harbour at Tokomaru Bay, and no further authority than this Act shall be required to vest the said lands in the said Council. Lands vested in Council as an endowment.

20 3. It shall be lawful for the Waiapu County Council to lease any portion or portions of the said lands, subject to the provisions of and in the manner prescribed by the Public Bodies' Leasing-powers Act, 1908. Power to lease.

## SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situated in the County of Waiapu, in the Provincial District of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 7,533 acres 2 roods, more or less (excluding from the said area a reserve containing 49 acres 2 roods, more or less), called or known as the "Huiarua No. 1. Block," bounded on the north by the Huiarua No. 3 Block, on the east by the Tauwhareparae Block, on the south by the Tauwhareparae Block and the Waipaoa No. 1 Block respectively, and on the west by the Waipaoa No. 1A and the Waipaoa No. 1c Block respectively.
