A BILL INTITULED

An Act to confer Further Powers on the Wellington Title. City Corporation.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Short Title. Empowering and Amendment Act, 1940.
- 2. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the Interpretation. 10 context,—
 - "Corporation" means the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors, and citizens of the City of Wellington.
- 3. The purposes for which the land described in Variation of 15 the Schedule hereto is held by the Corporation—namely, trust of held by are hereby cancelled, and it is hereby declared that the said Corporation shall in future hold the said lend the said Corporation shall in future hold the said land municipal for general municipal purposes.

Alteration of position of accessway to Nikau Street over Newtown Library site in the City of Wellington.

4. Part III of the Schedule to the Wellington City Empowering Act, 1930, is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:—

" PART III.

"All that piece of land situate in the City of Wellington, containing one perch and four-tenths of a perch (1.4 perches), be the same a little more or less, being part of Reserve 13, Town of Wellington, as the same is more particularly delineated on a plan deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Wellington as No. 20550 and thereon coloured red."
