A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to confer Further Powers on the Wellington Title.  
~~City Corporation~~ Council.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New  
5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Short Title.  
Empowering and Amendment Act, 1940.

2. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the Interpretation.  
10 context,—

“Corporation” means the Corporation of the  
Mayor, Councillors, and citizens of the City  
of Wellington.

3. The purposes for which the land described in Variation of  
15 the Schedule hereto is held by the Corporation—namely, trust of land  
held by  
Corporation in  
Waipapa Road  
to general  
municipal  
purposes.  
the purposes of a public-library and town-hall site—  
are hereby cancelled, and it is hereby declared that  
the said Corporation shall in future hold the said land  
for general municipal purposes.

4. Part III of the Schedule to the Wellington City Empowering Act, 1930, is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:—

“ PART III.

“ All that piece of land situate in the City of Wellington, containing one perch and ~~four tenths of a perch (1.4 perches)~~ *sixty-seven hundredths of a perch (1.67 perches)*, be the same a little more or less, being part of Reserve 13, Town of Wellington, and being part of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 455, folio 169, Wellington Registry, as the same is more particularly delineated on a plan deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Wellington as No. 29550 20615 and thereon coloured ~~red~~ *blue*.”

ALL that piece of land situate in the City of Wellington, containing one rood nine perches and four-tenths of a perch (1 rood 9.4 perches), being Lot 44, Block VI, on Deposited Plan No. 1621, being part of Section 2 3, Evans Bay District, and being the ~~balance~~ *residue* of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 145, folio 256, Wellington Registry.
