## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to enlarge the Time wherein Reserves for Natives may be made Title. under "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1880."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament 5 assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, Short Title. 1882."
- The period during which reserves of land may be made by the Governor under the second section of "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1880," is two years.
   hereby extended, and any such reserve may be made under the aforesaid section at any time before the expiration of two years from the passing of this Act.
