A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Wellington City Milk-supply Act, 1919, as Titl amended by the Wellington City Milk-supply Amendment Act, 1926.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington City Milk-supply Amendment Act, 1928, and shall be read together with and deemed part 10 of the Wellington City Milk-supply Act, 1919, as amended by the Wellington City Milk-supply Amendment Act, 1926.

2. Sections nineteen, twenty, twenty-one, and twenty-two of the Wellington City Milk-supply Amendment Act, 1926, are hereby repealed.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Wellington City Milk-supply Act, 1919, as amended by the Wellington City Milk-supply Amendment Act, 1926, or in this Act, milk produced at dairies situate in the city, or situated or lying wholly or partly within two miles of the city as it existed on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, may be sold on or after the first day of August, nineteen 20 hundred and twenty-eight, within the city without any restrictions whatsoever from the Wellington City Council.

4. In case of a sudden emergency or of a shortage in the supply of any near-by farmer it shall be lawful for any such near-by farmer to purchase from any source whatever additional milk to make up the normal supply of milk of such near-by farmer.
