A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Management of certain Title. Parcels of Land in the City of Wellington.

WHEREAS by grant from the Crown dated the third day of June Preamble. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one the land firstly described in the First Schedule hereto annexed and hereinafter referred to as the Town Belt was granted to Isaac Earl Featherston then Super-

- 5 intendent of the Province of Wellington in trust for purposes of public utility to the Town of Wellington and its inhabitants And whereas by another grant from the Crown dated the said third day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one the land secondly described in the said First Schedule hereto annexed and hereinafter referred to as
- 10 the Canal and Basin Reserve was also granted to the said Isaac Earl Featherston Superintendent as aforesaid in trust for purposes of public utility to the town of Wellington and its inhabitants
- And whereas by an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington infituled an Act for the better 15 management of certain parcels of land in the City of Wellington certain provisions were made for the management of the lands granted as aforesaid: And whereas it is expedient that the said recited Act should be repealed and whereas by grant from the Crown dated the twenty-seventh day of October one thousand eight hundred and fifty-
- 20 two the lands described in the Second Schedule hereunto annexed and hereinafter referred to as the Wesleyan Reserve was granted to James No. 57-1.

Watkin Superintendent of Wesleyan Missions for the Province of Wellington and his successors in that office: And whereas the said James Watkin as such grantee acting with the consent of the governing body of the Wesleyan denomination entered into arrangements with the said Isaac Earl Featherston as such Superintendent as aforesaid 5 for the sale to him of the said land so granted by the said lastly recited deed of grant but such arrangements were never fully carried into effect And whereas doubts have arisen whether the said James Watkin can make a valid title to the said land and it is expedient to remove such doubts And whereas it is expedient to make provision 10 for the future management of as well of the said lands described in the First Schedule hereunto annexed as of the said Wesleyan Reserve when the same shall have been conveyed to the Superintendent for the time being of the said Province of Wellington as hereinafter provided :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wellington City Reserves Act 1871."

2. The hereinbefore recited Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington is hereby repealed saving nevertheless to all persons any rights which they may have acquired thereunder.

3. For the purpose of carrying into effect any arrangement for 25 the sale or conveyance of the Wesleyan Reserve to the Superintendent for the time being of the said Province of Wellington the said James Watkin his heirs or assigns shall within six calendar months after the passing of this Act convey to the said Superintendent and his successors the land described in the Second Schedule hereunto 30 annexed and from and after the execution of such conveyance the said land shall be deemed to be absolutely freed and discharged from all trusts theretofore affecting the same.

4. The Superintendent for the time being of the said Province of Wellington may with the advice and consent of his Executive Council 35 from time to time convey the whole or any part or parts of the land comprised in the first Schedule hereunto annexed to a Board of Commissioners to be appointed in manner hereinafter mentioned (and hereinafter called the Board) to hold the same to the Board and their successors upon trust for such purposes of public utility to the 40 City of Wellington and its inhabitants and with such powers as shall in and by the deed or deeds of conveyance thereof be expressed and declared but no power shall be given to the Board to alienate any part of the said lands otherwise than by lease or for any time or period exceeding twenty one years in possession without any covenant or 45 condition for renewal.

5. The Board shall consist of two ex officio and of three nominated and of four clected Commissioners and at all meetings of the Board three of the Commissioners shall be a quorum.

6. The ex officio Commissioners shall be the Superintendent for 50 the time being of the Province of Wellington and the Mayor for the time being of the Borough of Wellington.

7. The nominated Commissioners shall be such persons as shall from time time be appointed by the Governor in Council and shall hold office for three years from the date of nomination.

8. The elected Commissioners shall be such persons as shall from time to time be elected by the rate payers of the Borough of Wellington and shall also hold office for three years from the date of election.

9. The ex officio and nominated members of the Board in the first instance and after the election of the first elected members then 60 the Board shall make all such regulations as may be necessary for the

The Board shall be a body corporate by the name of the Board to be a cor-Б Wellington Reserves Commissioners with perpetual succession and a poration. common seal and shall have and possess all such powers as may be necessary for fully giving effect to the trusts and powers declared and contained in any Deed of conveyance to be made them as aforesaid.
- 11. The Superintendent for the time being of the said Province of Superintendent to 10 Wellington may with the advice and consent of his Executive Council Garden Governors of the Botanic Gardens created under part of land in the provisions of "The Botanic Gardens Act 1869," all or any second Schedule. part of the land described in the Second Schedule hereunto annexed to
- 15 hold the same unto the said Board of Governors upon trust for such purposes of public utility to the City of Wellington and its inhabitants and with such powers as shall in and by the deed or deeds of conveyance thereof be expressed and declared.
- 12. The said Superintendent may with the advice and consent Superintendent may 20 aforesaid appropriate any part of the said land described in the said set apart land for Lunatic Asylum. second Schedulc hereunto annexed to the purposes of a Lunatic Asylum for the Province of Wellington and of grounds to be annexed thereto and may convey the same to Trustees for the purposes of such Asylum in such manner and subject to such conditions as to the said 25 Superintendent with the advice and consent aforesaid shall seem meet.
