An Act to amend "The Wellington City Streets Act, 1899." BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Wellington City Streets Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read Short Title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Council of the City of Wellington by special order to declare any now existing private street or private streets may be way laid out in the City of Wellington, of the width of twenty feet declared public or more, to be a public street of such city, and thereupon such private streets. street or private way shall become a public street accordingly.
