ANALYSIS.

Title.  
1. Short Title.

2. Existing private streets may be declared public streets.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Wellington City Streets Act, 1899."  
BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

Title.

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Wellington City Streets  
Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read  
together with "The Wellington City Streets Act, 1899."

Short Title.

10 2. It shall be lawful for the Council of the City of Wellington  
by special order to declare any now existing private street or private  
way laid out in the City of Wellington, of the width of twenty feet  
or more, to be a public street of such city, and thereupon such private  
street or private way shall become a public street accordingly.

Existing private streets may be declared public streets.
