A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The West Coast Settlement Reserves Act, Title. 1892."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The West Coast Settlement Short Title. Reserves Act Amendment Act, 1900."

2. Section twelve of "The West Coast Settlement Reserves Amended power as by repealing subsection five thereof, and substituting in lieu thereof

> for a reasonable rent, upon a tenancy of not more than seven years' duration.

3. Section twenty-two of the said Act is hereby amended by Power to acquire adding the following subsection, to follow subsection two, that is to say :-

"(3.) Acquire by purchase or exchange land other than that included in such reserves, where such acquisition is necessary for the purpose of gaining access to such reserves."

4. The proviso to the aforesaid section twenty-two is hereby Extended time for amended by repealing the words "seven years," and substituting in repaying advances. 25 lieu thereof the words "twenty-one years."
