A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Workers' Dwellings Act, 1905." Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Workers' Dwellings Short Title. Act Amendment Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Workers' Dwellings Act, 1905" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. The Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council Defence reserves **1**0 gazetted, set apart under the principal Act the Polhill Gully and may be set apart under the principal the Forts Reserve, Miramar, and any other land reserved for defence Act. purposes that in his opinion is not required for such purposes, in the same manner as if the same were ordinary Crown land.

3. Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 4 of repealing the words "three hundred pounds," and substituting in principal Act amended. 15 lieu thereof the words "three hundred and fifty pounds if constructed of wood, or four hundred pounds if constructed of brick."
