## WORKERS' DWELLINGS ACT AMENDMENT.

## ANALYSIS.

## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Workers' Dwellings Act, 1905."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Workers' Dwellings Act short Title. Amendment Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Workers' Dwellings Act, 1905" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by Definition of worker repealing the words "one hundred and fifty-six" in the definition of amended. "worker," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "two hundred."

3. Where more workers than one apply for the same workers' Preference to dwelling, preference may be given to him who has the lesser income, has the lesser provided he is of good character, and the Board is satisfied as to his income.
