A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the War Damage Act, 1941. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the War Damage Short Title.
Amendment Act, 1942, and shall be read together with
and deemed part of the War Damage Act, 1941

10 2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby Extending

amended as from the passing thereof by inserting in
the definition of the term "war damage" in sub-
section one, after paragraph (d), the following para-
graph:—

15 " (e) Damage occurring (whether accidentally or
not) as the direct result of measures taken
under proper authority with a view to
destroying any property for the purpose of
preventing it from falling into the hands of
20 the enemy or being used by the enemy: ".
