A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to authorise and empower the Whakatane
District Council to expend money from its Harbour
Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund for disaster
5 recovery**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Whakatane
District Council Empowering Act 1987.

**2. Council may expend money in Harbour Capital
10 Expenditure Reserve Fund for disaster recovery**—
(Notwithstanding) For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby
delared that, notwithstanding anything in any enactment or
rule of law, the Whakatane District Council is (*hereby*)
authorised and empowered to expend, for the purposes of
15 recovery within its district from (*any natural disaster*) the
earthquake which occurred on the 2nd day of March 1987 and
the aftershocks, such amount of money (not exceeding a total
sum of \$500,000) as it thinks fit from the Council's Harbour
