A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to repeal certain Enactments imposing Disabilities on Former Title. Alien Enemies and other Persons.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the War Disabilities Removal Short Title. Act, 1927.

10 2. The enactments referred to in the Schedule hereto are hereby Repeals. repealed to the extent indicated in the Schedule.
