A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower the Wellington Hospital Board, the Wellington Harbour Board, the Hutt County Council, and the Makara County Council to contribute to the New Zealand Free Ambulance Transport Service (Wellington District), Incorporated.

WHEREAS the Wellington Hospital Board, the Wellington Harbour Board, the Hutt County Council, and the Makara County Council have been accustomed, pursuant to Legislative authority obtained annually, to pay contributions to the New Zealand Free Ambulance Transport Service (Wellington District), Incorporated: And whereas it is expedient that the said local authorities should be empowered from time to time to make contributions to the said corporation:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington Free Ambulance Act, 1941.

Certain local authorities empowered to contribute to the New Zealand Free Ambulance Transport Service (Wellington District), Incorporated.

2. The Wellington Hospital Board, the Wellington Harbour Board, the Hutt County Council, and the Makara County Council, and each of them, are hereby authorized and empowered to pay to the New Zealand Free Ambulance Transport Service (Wellington District), Incorporated, in the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and forty-two, and in any and every year thereafter, such sums as from time to time they respectively think fit.
