A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Amend the Whakatane Harbour Act, 1921-22. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the Whakatane Harbour Amendment Act, 1950, and shall form part of and be read together with the Whakatane Harbour Act, 1921-22 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.
- 10 2. [(1)] The Whakatane Harbour District constituted by the principal Act, as [amended by] described in the First Schedule to the Whakatane Harbour Amendment Act, 1928, is hereby extended to include the [area] areas described in the Schedule to this Act. Whakatane Harbour District extended.

(2) The principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by the addition of the said area to the First Schedule to the Whakatane Harbour Amendment Act, 1928.

AREA EXCLUDED FROM COUNTY OF OPOTIKI AND INCLUDED IN
COUNTY OF WHAKATANE

ALL that area containing approximately 4,000 acres, being part of the Opotiki County, and situated in Blocks II, III, V, VI, and VII, Whakatane Survey District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in Block III aforesaid at the eastern end of Ohope Beach, being the westernmost corner of Lot 140 (recreation reserve), as shown on the plan numbered 22193, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland, being part of Allotment 246A, No. 2, Waimana Parish, and running easterly along the shore of the Bay of Plenty to the eastern extremity of Ohope Land Spit; thence due south along a right line for a distance of 500 links; thence due south-west along a right line to its intersection with a right line from the southern extremity of Allotment 249, Waimana Parish (Ohakana Island) passing through a point 100 links due north of the northern extremity of Section 284, Waimana Parish (Uretara Island); thence westerly along the last-mentioned right line to the southern extremity of Allotment 249 aforesaid, and a right line to a point distant 1000 links from and due west of the northern extremity of Allotment 127, Waimana Parish (Whitiwhiti Point); thence south-westerly along a right line to a point, being the intersection of the northern boundary of that part of Lot 2, to the north-west of Wainui Road as shown on the plan numbered 12843, deposited as aforesaid, with the mean high water mark of the Ohiwa Harbour aforesaid; thence westerly generally along the said northern boundary and along a right line, being the last-mentioned boundary produced

across the aforesaid Wainui Road to its western side; thence northerly generally along the boundary of the Whakatane County, as described in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 109, of the 31st day of October, 1940, page 2780, to the point of commencement: as the same is shown edged red on plan marked M.D. 9059, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department, at Wellington.

AREAS ADDED TO THE WHAKATANE HARBOUR DISTRICT

ALL that area of approximately 2,600 acres in the South Auckland Land District, situated in Blocks II, III, V, VI, and VII, Whakatane Survey District, being that part of the County of Whakatane, bounded by a line commencing at the north-western corner of Lot 140, as shown on the plan numbered 11193, deposited in the Auckland Land Registry Office, being part of Allotment 246A, No. 2, of the Parish of Waimana, and running easterly generally along the shore of the Bay of Plenty to the eastern extremity of Ohope Land Spit; thence south-westerly generally along the line of mean high-water on the northern and western shores of the Ohiwa Harbour to and along the generally northern and eastern sides of Wainui Road to the northern boundary of that part of Lot 2, to the north-west of the aforesaid Wainui Road, as shown on the plan numbered 12843, deposited as aforesaid, being part of Allotment 245, of the Parish of Waimana aforesaid; thence westerly generally along the said northern boundary and along a right line, being the last-mentioned boundary produced, across the said Wainui Road to its western side; thence north-westerly generally along the generally south-western side of Wainui Road aforesaid, along a right line across the aforesaid Road, to and north-easterly generally along the north-western side of Ohope Road, to and along the south-western boundary of Lot 140 aforesaid to its north-western corner, being the point of commencement:

Also all that area of approximately 112 acres in the South Auckland Land District, situated in Blocks III and VI, Whakatane Survey District, being that part of the County of Whakatane known as Ohakana Island, and being Allotment 249 of the Parish of Waimana:
