2. Power to construct roads and develop coal-measures.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorise the Expenditure of Moneys in the Construction of Roads over the Endowments of the Westport Harbour Board, and in the Development of the Coal-measures therein. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Westport Harbour Board Endowments Act, 1900." Short Title.

10 2. It shall be lawful for the Westport Harbour Board, out of its revenues, to expend moneys, not exceeding two thousand pounds in any one year, in constructing roads over the lands referred to in subsection one of section seven of "The Westport Harbour Board Act, 1884"; and also, out of any revenues in excess of the ordinary requirements of the Board, to expend moneys, not exceeding two Power to construct roads and develop coal-measures.
15 thousand pounds in any one year, in prospecting for coal on the said lands, or in extinguishing fires in coal-mines therein, or in developing in any manner the coal-measures therein.
