WELLINGTON HARBOUR BOARD EMPOWERING.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to remove certain Restrictions from Land at Worser Bay Title. vested in the Board and to confer certain powers upon the Board.

WHEREAS by the Wellington Harbour Board and Corporation Land Act, 1880, the land described in the First Schedule hereto, less the area which has since accreted to it, was vested in the Wellington Harbour Board for the purposes for which the Board was constituted. 10 subject to the restrictions imposed by section five of the said Act: And whereas it is expedient that the Board should have power to lease the said land:

BE IT therefore ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same. 15 as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wellington Harbour Board Short Title. Empowering Act, 1912.

Struck out.

2. "The Board" means the Wellington Harbour Board as constituted under the Harbours Act, 1908.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained to the contrary in section five of the Wellington Harbour Board and Corporation Land Act, 1880, the Board shall have the same power to lease the land described in the First Schedule hereto not required for roads as it how has or hereafter shall have in respect to lands vested in the Board without restriction.

4. The Board may dedicate for the purposes of a public road. free from any restrictions imposed by the Wellington Harbour Board and Corporation Land Act, 1880, so much of the land in the First 30 Schedule hereto as is described in the Second Schedule hereto; and also, in addition to or in substitution for part thereof, any other parts of the land described in the First Schedule as may be agreed upon between the Board and the Miramar Borough Council.

2. (1.) The restrictions imposed on the Wellington Harbour Bo rd by section five of the Wellington Harbour Board and Corporation Land Act, 1880, with respect to the alienation by way of lease of certain lands mentioned in that section shall not apply with respect to the lands mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, and with regard to those lands the Board shall have the same powers of leasing as it has with regard to lands vested in it without restriction.

(2.) The Board may dedicate as a public road such portions of the lands mentioned in the said section five as it deems necessary

for the purposes of such leasing.

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3. (1.) The said Board shall have power to and shall grant a lease to the Corporation of the Borough of Miramar (hereinafter referred to as the lessee) of the land described in the Second Schedule hereto at an annual rent of one peppercorn for a term of nine hundred and ninety-nine years, subject to the payment by the lessee of all rates and taxes payable in respect of the said land, and subject also in the event of the whole or any part of the said land being required by the Board for harbour purposes to the right of the Board at any time to resume possession of the land so required.

(2.) The land so leased shall at all times during the currency of 20 the lease be held by the lessee for the purposes of public recreation, or of assisting and encouraging the sports of swimming, boating, fishing, and sailing.
