A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to reserve Land as an Endowment for the Wairoa Harbour Board.

Title.

WHEREAS the Wairoa Harbour Board is a duly constituted Harbour Board under and by virtue of the Wairoa Harbour Board Act, 1878: And whereas it is expedient that the lands described in the Schedule hereto should be vested in the said Board for the purposes and with the powers hereinafter mentioned:

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Wairoa Harbour Board Endowment Act, 1914.

Short Title.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Act are hereby set aside and reserved as an endowment for the Harbour of Wairoa.

Lands set aside as an endowment.

3. The lands referred to in the *last preceding* section are by this Act vested for an estate in fee-simple in the Wairoa Harbour Board for the purposes declared in the *last preceding* section hereof, and freed and discharged of and from all trusts or reservations now or heretofore affecting or declared of or concerning the same, save and except any rights of road which may now be subsisting over or in respect of the same.

Lands vested in Wairoa Harbour Board.

4. The said Wairoa Harbour Board shall have and may exercise in respect of the said lands or any part or parts thereof all leasing-powers for the time being vested in Harbour Boards.

Schedule.

ALL that area in the Hawke's Bay Land District, containing by admeasurement 1,001 acres and 26 perches, more or less, being Section No. 21, Block XII, Taramarama Survey District: bounded towards the north by Section No. 125, Block VIII; towards the east by Mangaruhe No. 1 Block and Section No. 20, Block XII, aforesaid; towards the south by Section No. 28; and towards the west by Section No. 35 in Blocks VIII and XII aforesaid.
