An Act to grant Further Borrowing Powers to the Westport Title. Harbour Board.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Westport Harbour Short Title. Board Loan Act, 1900."

2. In addition to any moneys authorised to be borrowed under Board authorised to 10 "The Westport Harbour Board Act, 1884," "The Westport Harbour sum not exceeding Board Loan Act, 1896," and "The Westport Harbour Board Act, £50,000. 1897," the Westport Harbour Board shall have power from time to time to borrow, on the security of its endowments, subject to the provisions of "The Harbours Act, 1878," and to the Governor's pre-15 vious approval of the works proposed to be constructed, any sum not exceeding fifty thousand pounds for the construction or completion of harbour-works in or towards the improvement of the Harbour of Westport, and for providing rolling-stock and additional railway facilities for the Westport-Mokihinui Railway.
