A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Part of the Foreshore within the Harbour of Whangarei and situated in and about Urquhart's Bay within the said Harbour in the Whangarei Harbour Board. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Whangarei Harbour Board Vesting and Empowering Act, 1925. Short Title.

10 2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of the Harbours Act, 1923, Act deemed to be a special Act.

Struck out.

15 which is accordingly incorporated herewith, and shall be read and construed along with the Whangarei Harbour Act, 1907.

3. On the passing of this Act the lands described in the Schedule hereto, excepting any Native land as defined by the Native Land Act, 1909, and any Native fishing-ground and fisheries, shall vest in and be the property of the Whangarei Harbour Board (hereinafter called the Board) as endowment lands: Vesting lands in Board.

20 Provided that nothing herein shall affect any rights or powers of the Crown or shall interfere with the riparian rights of His Majesty or of any other person.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that portion of land containing 10 acres 1 rood 33 perches, more or less, in that portion of the Whangarei Harbour known as Urquhart's Bay, situated in Block VIII, Ruakaka Survey District, and lying between high- and low-water mark at ordinary spring tides, as shown upon the plan coloured pink deposited herewith coloured pink upon the plan marked M.D. 6062, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington.
