A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to establish the County of Waimate as a Separate Hospital and Charitable Aid District. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Waimate Hospital District Act, 1891." Short Title.

2. From and after the thirteenth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, the County of Waimate, including all boroughs therein, shall cease to be included in the Hospital District of South Canterbury, and shall, as from the said date, be constituted a hospital district under the said Act, by the name of the "District of Waimate;" and the District Board for the said District of Waimate shall consist of the Chairman of the County Council of Waimate, the Mayor of the Borough of Waimate, and three members of the County Council and one member of the Borough Council, to be selected by the said Councils. Waimate Hospital District constituted.

3. On the constitution of the said Hospital District of Waimate by severance from the former District of South Canterbury,— Previous funds, how apportioned.

(1.) All the assets and liabilities of the former district at the time when such severance takes effect shall be apportioned between the Boards of the former district and of the new district, in such manner and proportions as shall be allocated by any person who may be appointed in that behalf by the Governor;

(2.) The Councils of the boroughs and counties within the new district shall, within thirty days after the constitution of the said district, elect the first Board for the new district, Election of Board.

which shall come into office forthwith on its election, but shall hold office only until their successors, elected on the then next fourth Wednesday in November, shall come into office; and the Governor shall appoint the time and place for the first meeting of such Board;

(3.) All proceedings in relation to any such election shall be had, as far as may be, in manner as directed by "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885."

4. The First Schedule of "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885," is hereby amended as follows, that is to say,—

In the description of the South Canterbury District, before the word "Mackenzie," insert "and," and omit the word "Waimate."

After the aforesaid description, insert

"DISTRICT OF WAIMATE.

"All that area in the colony being the County of Waimate, including all boroughs therein."
