A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, Title. 1885."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in

5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Woodville Hospital Short Title. District Act, 1892." It shall be read and construed together with "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885," herein referred to as "the said Act."

2. The said Act is hereby amended as follows:—

The First Schedule of the said Act is hereby amended as follows: Schedules in "Hospitals and In the description of the District of Wairarapa, after the word "west" Charitable insert the words "except those portions of the said counties now Institutions Act, forming the County of Pahiatua." In the description of the District 15 of Waipawa, after the word "Patangata" insert the words "except

the Danevirke and Woodville Ridings of the said Waipawa County; and, after the description of the District of Waipawa, insert "District of Woodville. All that area in the colony, being the County of Pahiatua and the Woodville and Danevirke Ridings of the County of 20 Waipawa, and including all the boroughs therein.'

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in section thirty-four of Separation of the said Act, the District of Woodville shall hereby be separated from districts. the United District of Wairarapa and Wellington and the United

District of Waipawa and Hawke's Bay.

4. For the District of Woodville there shall be a District Board Appointment of District Board. as District Board. of administration, to consist of twelve members, to be elected as follows:—

The Council of the County of Pahiatua shall elect three members; the Pahiatua Town Board shall elect one member; the Wood-30 ville Borough Council shall elect two members; the Danevirke Town

Board shall elect one member; the Danevirke Road Board shall elect two members; the Woodville Road Board and the Mangaatua Road Board shall together elect one member; the Maharahara Road Board and the Kumeroa Road Board shall together elect one member; and voluntary subscribers to the hospital funds of ten shillings and upwards shall elect one member. Six members to form a quorum.

First election of Board.

5. The first Board shall be elected within two calendar months after this Act comes into force, and thereafter the said Board shall be elected annually, at some time during the same month as the first Board is elected.

Vesting of certain lands.

6. The lands described in the First and Second Schedules hereto, being a cemetery reserve and a hospital reserve respectively, are hereby vested in the Woodville Hospital Board for an estate in feesimple, with all the powers and for the purposes authorised by the said Act; and the District Land Registrar at Napier is hereby empowered to issue certificates of title for the said pieces of land in the name of the Woodville Hospital Board.

Removal of corpses.

7. The Board of the District of Woodville is hereby empowered and required to remove the bodies of all persons buried in the piece of land described in the First Schedule hereto, and to re-inter such 20 bodies in the Woodville Public Cemetery within six months after this Act comes into force.

Power of Board to sell certain portions of land. 8. It shall be lawful for the said Board from time to time, with the consent in writing of the Inspector of Institutions under the said Act, to sell by public auction or private contract all or any part 25 of the lands mentioned in the First and Second Schedules hereto, either together or separately, under and subject to conditions to be approved by such Inspector; but all moneys received from such sale or sales shall be laid out and expended in or towards providing another site, to be approved by such Inspector, and in erecting the necessary 30 buildings, fixtures, and improvements thereon.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece of land containing by admeasurement 5 acres, more or less, being Allotment No. 1 of Rural Section No. 14, Woodville, as shown on the plan deposited in the Land Transfer Office, Napier, as No. 401.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece of land containing by admeasurement 1 acre 1 rood 3 perches, more or less, being Suburban Section No. 46 on the plan of the Township of Woodville.
