A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to amend the Waterfront Industry Commission
Act 1976**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 5 **1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Waterfront Industry Commission Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Waterfront Industry Commission Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 10 (2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.
- 2. Officers of Commission**—Section 53 (4) of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
- 15 **3. Remuneration, travelling expenses, and administrative expenses**—The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 54 (as substituted by section 24 (1) of the Waterfront Industry Commission Amendment Act 1987), and substituting the following section:
- 20 “54. (1) There shall be paid to the members and acting members of the Commission remuneration by way of fees, salaries, or allowances and travelling allowances and expenses

in accordance with the Fees and Travelling Allowances Act 1951, and the provisions of that Act shall apply accordingly as if each of those persons were a member of a statutory Board within the meaning of that Act.

“(2) The General Manager shall be paid such salary and such allowances as are from time to time determined by the State Services Commission and such additional allowances, being travelling allowances or other incidental or minor allowances, as are from time to time fixed by the Minister. 5

“(3) The other officers and employees of the Commission shall be employed on such terms and conditions of employment and shall be paid such salaries and allowances as the General Manager from time to time determines in agreement with the State Services Commission, or as the Minister from time to time determines in any case where the General Manager and the State Services Commission fail to agree. 10 15

“(4) All such payments and the administrative expenses of the Commission shall be paid out of the funds of the Commission”. 20

4. Repeal—Section 24 of the Waterfront Industry Commission Amendment Act 1987 is hereby consequentially repealed.
