A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Walsh and Others Pension Act, 1869." Title.

WHEREAS under "The Walsh and Others Pension Act, 1869" Preamble.

5 the same, an annuity for a limited time was granted to James Wilson, ordinarily known as James George Wilson, then an infant, the only surviving member of his family, which perished in the Poverty Bay massacre; and also certain persons were appointed by the Governor to select free of cost, in one allotment, or in more than one contiguous  
10 allotments, one hundred acres of land, to be granted to the said persons in trust for the said James Wilson, with power to them to lease the said lands for any term not exceeding twenty-one years, and a direction to convey the said lands to James Wilson on his attaining his majority, subject to any existing lease thereof:

15 And whereas the said James Wilson is by the said Act restricted to the same power of granting leases of the said land for a period of twenty-one years, and cannot enter into full possession thereof before the first day of January in the year one thousand nine hundred, when he will have attained the age of forty years, although he is empowered  
20 absolutely to dispose of the land by will should he die before the last-mentioned date:

And whereas the land selected and granted as aforesaid comprises one hundred acres, being section numbered eighty-two, Block I., Turanganui Survey District (otherwise known as "Block No. 841X,  
25 Patutahi District"), and being the whole of the land comprised and described in Crown grant registered in the books of the Land Transfer Office at Napier, in volume four, folio ninety-eight, is now vested in the said James George Wilson, subject to the conditions of the said Act:

30 And whereas the said James George Wilson, being at the time in ignorance of the restriction imposed by the said Act, executed to the Union Bank of Australia, Limited, a mortgage over the said land

to secure repayment of moneys advanced, which mortgage was accepted by the District Land Registrar at Napier, and duly registered on the Land Transfer Register as a valid mortgage :

And whereas it is expedient that the said land should be vested in the said James Wilson, otherwise James George Wilson, absolutely, free from any restriction on alienation, and subject only to the existing lease, and to the said mortgage to the Union Bank of Australia, Limited : 5

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 10 as follows :—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Wilson Land Act, 1894."

James George Wilson to hold the said land released from the restriction imposed by the said Act.

2. On and from the day on which the Governor assents to this Act, James George Wilson shall be seized of an estate of freehold of inheritance in fee-simple in the land, being section numbered eighty-two, Block I., Turanganui Survey District, containing one hundred acres more or less, altogether released from the restriction imposed on the tenure of the said land by the said Act, but subject to any existing lease of the said land or any part thereof, and subject also to any mortgage of the said land or any part thereof heretofore registered on the Land Transfer Register. 15 20

Repeals.

Sections seven, eight, and nine of the said Act are hereby repealed.

Act to be deposited with District Land Registrar.

3. James George Wilson shall, without unnecessary delay, deposit copy of this Act with the District Land Registrar of Hawke's Bay, who shall thereupon indorse on the Land Transfer Register, and on the Crown grant for the said land, a memorial of the effect of this Act. 25
