A BILL INTITULED

An Act to continue in office the Waste Lands Boards Title. of the several Land Districts of the Colony.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Waste Lands Boards Short Title.

5 Continuance Act, 1877."

2. The several persons who, on the last day of the month of November, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, constituted the Waste Lands Boards of the several land districts of Auckland, Taranaki, Hawke's Bay, Wellington, Nelson, Marlborough, Canterbury, Otago, Southland, and Westland, as the said districts are defined in the fourth section of "The Waste Lands Administration Act, 1876," shall continue to be, and shall be deemed to have continued from the herein first-mentioned day to be, the Waste Lands Boards under the aforesaid Act of such land districts respectively, and shall remain and be deemed to have remained in office from the aforesaid day until new Boards to be constituted under any Act of the General Assembly, to be hereafter passed, shall take office in their places respectively.

The Governor, by warrant under his hand may remove any 20 Commissioner of the Boards hereby continued in office, and all vacancies occurring in any of the said Boards shall be supplied by new

appointments by the Governor.

3. The provisions of "The Waste Lands Administration Act, Act of 1876 to apply 1876," shall apply to every Waste Lands Board hereby continued in to Boards.

25 office, and to every Commissioner thereof, in the same manner as if every such Board or Commissioner had been originally appointed under the aforesaid Act.
