A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Act, 1940. **Title.**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Amendment Act, 1946, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Act, 1940 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). **Short Title and commencement.**

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and forty-six.

2. (1) The principal Act (as amended by section two of the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Amendment Act, 1943) is hereby further amended by repealing the First, Second, and Third Schedules, and substituting therefor respectively the First, Second, and Third Schedules to this Act. 5

(2) Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (a), after the words "appropriate rate", the words "or rates".
